**COVID-19 Regulations
NEW Entry Requirements for International Visitors
to Swaziland / Eswatini**

Border Posts that are OPEN from South Africa :

OSHOEK : open 24-hours / JEPPEES REEF : 07h00-20h00 / MAHAMBA : 07h00 –22h00 /
GOLELA : 07h00 – 22h00 / MANANGA : 07h00 – 18h00 / Airport : Sikhuphe

Border Posts that are OPEN from Mozambique :

NAMAACHA : 07h00 – 00h00 / GOBA : 06h00-00h00

Social distancing : is mandatory for larger groups – but not for groups of less than 5 people

Face masks : are mandatory in indoor spaces

At a traffic / police checkpoint : vehicles with 5 or more occupants should wear masks

The Swaziland vaccination programme has speeded up . At present, all personnel working in the border posts, hotels, restaurants, etc have been fully vaccinated

VACCINATED Visitors :

Covid-19 Updated Regulations

As per the Statement issued on 29th March, 2022
by the Hon Cleopas Dlamini - Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Eswatini

On arrival at the Eswatini / Swaziland Border Post - Vaccinated Visitors can now present proof (written certificate) of their FULL vaccination : 2 vaccinations (or : J & J - one Vaccine)

UN-VACCINATED Visitors :

- including un-vaccinated Children (aged 5 to 12 years)

A certificate for a negative PCR test is required
